

## General Campground Rules

**No Alcohol Strictly enforced!!**

Check In Time is 2:00 pm, and Check Out Time is 1:00pm

- 1. Only one (1) tent/screen room in addition to your camper or 2 tents on your site.*
- 2. Maximum of 8 people per site*
- 3. Maximum Two vehicles (Boats, equip trailers included) overflow parking in designated area.*
- 4. If you have more than 4 people at your site a park usage fee of \$5.00 per person, per day, is added to your daily rate.*
- 5. Guest to your site is required to pay park usage fee of \$5.00 per person per day.*
- 6. Quiet hours are from 10:00 pm until 8:00 am. ( 11:00- 8:00 weekends & Holidays)*
- 7. 4 wheelers not allowed. (UTVs and Golf carts only, and min. 16 year old driver)*
- 8. You must keep site neat and clean.*
- 9. No Alcohol or fireworks**
- 10. No glass in restrooms or pool area*
- 11. Do not cut trees or brush or pick up firewood. ( No scavenging for wood)*
- 12. Put garbage in dumpster\* No household garbage in bathrooms or laundry*
- 13. No smoking in Buildings*
- 14. These rules are not all inclusive, others may be posted.*
- 15. No clotheslines.*
- 16. Pool and Trail closes at sunset*

### **PETS**

- 1. Pets cannot be left out alone and must have proof of current shots. Pets are allowed in the RV camping area only.*
- 2. **Pets outside must be on a short leash and attended at all times.***
- 3. **Pets will be limited to one animal per site. NO aggressive pets.***
- 4. **You MUST clean up and properly dispose of all waste from your pet.***
- 5. **Pets are not allowed at springs, pool or primitive campground.***

**\*Our garbage dumpster is a closed top dumpster. Please place trash inside through the doors on the sides. Do not throw trash on top of the dumpster.**

## Hart Springs is a **family oriented park.**

You need to know:

- Bicycles parked and children in campsite at 9:00 P.M.
- Golf carts parked, and guest leave at 10:00 P.M.
- Quiet time and front gate closed at 11:00 P.M. - 8:00 A.M.
- Quiet time means “noise must be contained within your campsite.”
- **Trail to RV Campground & Springs Closes at sunset.**
- **Alcohol is not allowed, strictly enforced!**
- **If a disturbance occurs, and alcohol is a factor, the Gilchrist County Sheriff’s Department will be called, and campsites involved will be trespassed immediately.**
- Guests are required to pay park usage fee.
- Children must be supervised by an adult at pool and springs.
- Wristbands must be sealed to wrist. They are required to use pool, or enter Springs Park. Replacement wristbands are free contact camp host, front gate, or store.
- No scavenging firewood from park property, No generators.
